# Grinnell UMC Church Council Minutes

December 16, 2025

Attendees: Ginny Cameron, Darwin Copeman, Jeanette Copeman, Andy Hamilton, Jerry Lane, Tim Niswander, Lyle Roudabush, Athen Schubert, Pastor Eric Schubert, Monique Shore, Mindy Tokle, and Carolyn Grosenbach.

Meeting was brought to order by Mindy Tokle. Devotions: Mindy shared Upper Room devotion: Simple Wonders - We need to pause to take in treasures around us. Getting to know each other - Favorite Christmas Tradition

Prayer Concerns and Joys were shared.

Minutes for October and November were approved as submitted

**Pastor's Report/Comments** - It has been busy but good kind of busy. If weird weather would quit happening on Saturday/Sunday would be better. Last Sunday was still good. Lots of people watched it on line and lots of kids were in front; blessing in many ways Caroling on Sunday went well. The kids that got drug along actually loved it and it was fun watching them see how people appreciated it. In thinking of how many people not there but still kids had fun when were back to eat together and running around and having fun at church; hope in that joy they see Jesus. Pastor Eric mentioned will be 4, 6 & 9pm for Christmas eve services this year; will see how this works. Also was noted some churches have different times for service. Athen commented thinking of going to different services as friend does to try out different religions.

## ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEES:

**Finance:** Jerry said was was busy month culminated in Confirmation Sunday. The budget was finalized and brought to last meeting where it was approved. Pledge cards were then sent out; no report yet.

**Memorial:** Don had submitted report earlier but give us update that \$1050.00 in memorial funds in honor or Elaine Noe were directed to Foundation.

**Foundation:** Lyle reported the endowed fund growing from \$50,000 to \$81,000. We can take out \$20,000 if needed. Some people giving are non-members. As of October of this year \$140,000 was given by two people to Foundation. Earnings this year totaled \$160,000; total is now \$1,700,000. Comment was made about possibility of insuring ourselves; it was also mentioned could look at taking bigger deduction to make premium less. Lyle has been handling Foundation Account for 16 years and in those years three large gifts totaling \$3 million were given to Foundation from members Elsie Johnston, Dennis Anderson and Gail & Margaret Wheeler. The Wheeler Fund still has \$175,00 left and just spent \$150,000 on windows. There have been 5 or 6 donations to Foundation around \$50,000 to \$60,000. This is Lyle's last year as Church Treasurer after taking on the position 17 years ago when Bob Kaloupek said "you need to do this". He mentioned the period of time when apportionments were very high and we didn't pay for awhile; apportionments came down in price and and we caught up. Many Thank You's were extended to Lyle by committee members for his years dedicated to this position.

**SPRC:** Dar reported primarily business was to finish discussion about budgeted funds for discretionary bonuses; they will be paid this year. Each person on committee will meet with a staff member to thank them personally.

**Trustees:** Jeanette reported the long awaited railings are installed and thanked everyone for patience. Because of Foundation and generous gifts that come through Foundation allows us to keep church fun good shape. Some tuck pointing is to get done yet but doing well. Sally Lang will be new trustee pending confirmation vote later in meeting.

Also noted that Brandon Dafoe is person doing sidewalk work and son is very ill. Pastor Eric mentioned that salt shouldn't be applied to sidewalks as have new cement; Jeanette will make contact on this.

## PROGRAM COMMITTEES:

**Connections:** Report submitted.

**Youth:** Athen said everything going well; they have gotten into groove with changes. Question was also asked about how food is handled now and she reported new way is working fine.

**Discipleship:** Andy said It was discussed that need to mobilize congregation to step in and learn what Cindy is doing. They are praying about this and have put together a list of names; maybe find someone that can step in for Sunday School, etc when Cindy can't be here. He also reported the committee discussed CAT Survey results.

**Service:** Ginny - CROPWALK raised over \$3,000. Some donations were sent in directly. Upcoming Christmas Dinner -It was noted information was distributed to about 25 places. Pastor Eric mentioned situation when he answered phone today, as Amy was home sick, one person called in and wanted 16 meals; he let them know we could only do 10 meals per family.

**Worship:** didn't meet this month. Comment made that Children's Program went together very easily even though weather interrupted practice.

## NEW BUSINESS:

Since Charge Conference there have been 3 more committee members to approve. Mindy offered to continue as chair of Church Council and suggested maybe to find vice-chair now to replace Connie. It was noted Scott Baumann has accepted position on Memorial Committee and Sally Lang as Trustee. Monique moved to approve the above listed, seconded by Dar. Motion carried.

**Leadership Training discussion:** Monique thinks Strategic Planning needs to be talked about every 5 years and Leadership Training on annual basis. January 17th is date set at this point for leadership training with 9-10 am being for new committee members with 10-12 noon be planning time for all committee members. Pastor Eric checked dates and January 10th would work for Strategic Planning; he wants staff there when it is done. Monique mentioned maybe do Strategic Planning same day as Leadership Training; discussion followed and several agreed with making that change. Also mentioned was possibility of moving 9-10 orientation to another date. Monique will check with Strategic Planning people about availability for January 17th. If they can come that day Eric will talk with Amy and Cindy to see if that day works for them, and if it does both the Strategic Planning and Leadership Training will be done on that day. Dar commented that facilitators would probably want a break in middle of day. He also posed question if the discussion of CAT survey needs to be done facilitator or could we handle that ourselves?
